

Code of Conduct - Responsibilities of Delegates

Infrastructure New Zealand (INZ) aims to provide a high quality, safe experience for all of our delegates. Our delegations operate at high pace and delegates are required to balance comprehensive content with opportunities to socialise and connect with hosts, other delegates and stakeholders in a professional manner. We expect high standards of behaviour to ensure the reputation of INZ and that of our delegation is preserved and enhanced. We hold our employees to these high standards and require all delegates to agree to equivalent standards.

Delegates will:

- Behave ethically, honestly and responsibly.
- Be aware of and comply with relevant laws and regulations.
- Ensure that confidential information remains confidential at all times
- Maintain a professional level of respect, courtesy and objectivity in all INZ delegation activities.
- Treat other delegates, hosts, sponsors, speakers and all associated parties with a professional level of respect, courtesy and dignity and reject discrimination, harassment or bullying on any grounds
- Ensure behaviour or actions do not cause public embarrassment or bring INZ's reputation into disrepute
- Ensure they do not use their position or any delegation information for personal benefit
